# IN CASE OF FIRE

## MTFD RAISES AWARENESS OF FIRE PREVENTION

Fire prevention is crucial for safety, focusing on proactive measures to minimize fire risks and mitigate potential damage. Year round, your Macomb Township Fire Prevention Division works hard to ensure residents have an understanding of fire hazards, preventative strategies and emergency response plans, reflecting the key elements of fire prevention: Education, Engineering and Enforcement.

### **Understanding Fire Hazards**

Fires often start from everyday hazards that get overlooked, like overloaded outlets, faulty wiring or improper storage of flammable materials. It's important to identify potential ignition sources and combustible materials to fully understand and assess the risk of fires in specific environments.

### **Implementing Preventative Measures**

When it comes to reducing the risk of fires in your home, small habits can make



a big difference, like maintaining a clean and clutter-free environment which reduces the risk of fire spread. Build a habit of checking to see that outlets are not being overloaded or extension cords misused, ensuring batteries are unplugged when not in use. ensuring cooking or open flames like candles are never left unattended, and maintaining safety equipment.

Smoke alarms should be tested monthly and the batteries replaced annually. The alarms should be replaced every 10 years. Fire extinguishers need to be replaced every 7 to 10 years, even if the gauge is green.

### Building Awareness

Educating and raising awareness of the importance of fire prevention is one of MTFD's top priorities. While the department spreads the word through programs and events, fire safety starts with you.

Help keep you and your family safe by conducting regular drills in your home to ensure everyone knows how to respond in an emergency and be sure to report fire hazards or unsafe conditions you see to the relevant

authorities. You can also take extra steps toward fire safety by investing in modern safety systems like smart fire detection systems or automated suppression systems.

### Fire Prevention Month

Fire safety is a lifelong lesson, and it starts early. Every October, the MTFD Fire Prevention Division reaches over 1,500 students, educating them on the importance of fire safety through school visits and field trips.

Every year, the National Fire Protection Association leads Fire Prevention Week, taking place this year from October 5 to October 11, 2025. This year's theme is "Charge into Fire Safety: Lithium-Ion Batteries in Your Home." The week will kick off with the annual **Macomb Township Fire Department Open House at Fire Station 3 on Sunday, October 5, 2025.** Bring the family over from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. for hands-on activities, fire truck tours and safety demonstrations!

## PUBLIC SAFETY AND ROAD INVESTMENTS HIGHLIGHT 2025-2026 TOWNSHIP BUDGET

In June, the Macomb Township Board approved a new fiscal year budget that adds two new sheriff's deputies and sets a record for road funding with no increase to residents' taxes. The \$14 million budgeted for road improvements smashes the previous record of \$6.5 million.

Macomb Township's population has increased by over 8% in the past ten years and the Township will have increased the number of law enforcement officers by over 53% during the same period.

"This budget continues to reflect the priorities of the Board, which are public safety and road improvements," Township Supervisor Frank Viviano said. "Every budget decision starts with considering the improvement to residents' quality of life."



Two Macomb County Sheriff's Deputies will join the ranks at the Macomb Township substation this year.

### INTERACTIVE FOUNTAIN & AMENITIES COMING TO TOWN SQUARE

Macomb Township kids will soon enjoy an interactive play fountain at the planned Town Square development thanks to a \$982,000 State of Michigan placemaking grant.

The grant is designed for projects that help communities create unique places for social gatherings and economic development.

This funding will also help add sidewalks and

outdoor restrooms to support events such as the Holiday Tree Lighting at Township Hall.

"The Township

Board been aggressively pursuing grant opportunities to bring residents' state tax dollars back to Macomb Township," said Macomb Township Treasurer Leon Drolet. "We fought to bring these funds back to our community, which will benefit all residents, especially our children and families."

Project Fire Buddies is a nonprofit that began as a grass roots effort in 2016 and has grown to include over 120 chapters across the country. ## Refund Policy

To be eligible for a refund, requests must be submitted no later than one business day before the class or program. By default, refunds will be issued as an in-house credit. Household credits, which can be used toward future activities, will be credited in full. If you prefer a refund to your original form of payment, please note that a \$10 processing fee will apply. Refunds will not be issued once a program has started. Additionally, there are no refunds for one-day trips, special events or single day classes.

## MTRC Rules & Policies:

- Photo ID required every visit.
- 10 years and under must be directly supervised by an adult.
- 11 years to 9th grade must have an adult in the facility, but not directly supervised.
- 9th grade+ can be unsupervised but must provide photo ID every visit.

## Dress Code

You may notice a lot of red this time which is not a concern but because Macomb Twp. has a much higher amount of new construction sales which are impacted by fiscal considerations in Q4 than in other quarterly comparisons.

**Average Sale Price – Healthy:** The important number here is year over year which is positive.

**Number of Sales – Healthy:** Again year over year is positive.

**Days on Market (DOM) – Neutral:** Market strength continues although for sellers who are accustomed to a faster pace, at 53 days it may seem sluggish.

**Inventory – Good:** The increase year over year of more than 25% is great news for buyers wanting to move into the Township.

**Absorption Rate – Seller's market:** At 22.4% sellers need to take into consideration the condition of the home when pricing it, because buyers will. It may be wiser to make some medium-priced upgrades, where maintenance issues are obvious, otherwise buyers may deduct the cost of premium work when making an offer.

*The Absorption Rate is a frequently used metric by home builders. When it is between 15.4% and 18.3% it is considered a market in balance. Higher percentages favors sellers, lower percentages favors buyers. At the height of the Great Recession the Absorption Rate was below 4%.*
