Fire Station 2 renovations complete!

Macomb Township Fire Station 2 has a new look! Originally built in 1984, Station 2 had not seen any upgrades since first being put into service. Renovations began last fall to give the building modern amenities that will help our firefighters better serve and protect the residents of Macomb Township. These renovations included adding 2,700 sq ft. of space, renovating 11,000 sq ft. of space, adding new technology and sleeping quarters and expanding the day room and offices. Toward the end of February, a package of bills was introduced in the Michigan House of Representatives in response to the need for more affordable housing and an increased housing supply. However, this legislation would essentially give developers the right to build in our community without any input from residents or local officials. 
