6. NOTICE TO APPLICANT

Mechanical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Macomb Township. All installations shall be in conformance with the Mechanical Code.
Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A permit will be closed when no inspections are requested and conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection. Closed permits cannot be refunded or reinstated.
