ACT 345 FIRE PENSION SYSTEM (4-year term)

Five Positions with two "at large" Positions. Must be a resident. Oversees the full-time fire fighter pension accounts.

BOARD OF REVIEW (2-year term)

Three Positions. Must be a resident. Reviews tax assessment appeals.

CLINTON-MACOMB PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES (4-year term)

Three Positions. Must be a resident. Oversees library operations & budget.

BUILDING BOARD OF APPEALS (2-year term)

Five Positions. Reviews proper zoning uses.

ETHICS BOARD (1, 2, 3 years initially, then 3-year term)

Three Positions. Must be a resident.

HISTORICAL COMMISSION (3-year term)

Seven Positions. Must be a resident. Promotes and preserves Macomb Township history.

PLANNING COMMISSION (3-year term)

Seven Positions. Must be a resident and a registered voter. Reviews and votes on all development except in the Town Center Area.

ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS (3-year term)

Seven Positions. Must be a resident. Decides all variance and definition requests regarding land division and development ordinances.

WATER SYSTEM ADVISORY COUNCIL (3-year term)

Five Positions with one "at large" Position. Must be a resident and who is a customer of the Macomb Township public water system and who does not normally represent the interests of any incorporated organization.
