



A Letter from the Director

Dear Resident,

The Parks and Recreation Millage expires at the end of 2022. Many things have been accomplished since the Millage passed in 2002. Waldenburg Park, Macomb Corners Park, and the Recreation Center all became a reality because of the millage. Sometime this summer we will break ground on Pitchford Park. Last year at Macomb Corners Park 5,429 players on 444 teams played 2,334 games, as we service the Macomb Township Little League, Clinton Macomb girls softball and AYSO soccer.



The Recreation Center opened in 2004. Prior to the pandemic, we averaged 750 visits per day. Steadily, we are approaching those numbers again. Since opening we have had 24,174 enrollments in swim lessons here at the pool. We have also hosted 7,133 birthday parties. In 2021,

14,438 participants enrolled in the 1,360 programs that were offered by our department. The Parks and Recreation Millage has been the major revenue source to allow us to improve the quality of life here in Macomb Township. We believe that the benefits are endless from us providing Parks and Recreation services to our residents. We continue to create community through people, parks, and programs. Please remember to vote on August 2nd, 2022.
